NOTE: The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

A Newcomer becomes an Aurovillian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.

The date of becoming Aurovillian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovillian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.

A confirmed Aurovillian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).

A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.

A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

PASSING ON: SHRADDHAVAN



This is to inform the community that Shradhdhavan of Savitri Bhavan left her body in the Sri Aurobindo's Nursing Home where she had been taken several weeks ago. She was just 80 years old. In November 1970 she came to Pondicherry and met the Mother who accepted her for Auroville.

Shradhdhavan has been with us since 1971 and was the initiative taker of Savitri Bhavan and its main guiding force. Further details and obituary will follow as and when they reach us.

Shree Krishna, Himself has pronounced the term 'Shradhdhavan' (Adorer) while narrating the Bhagavad Gita.

'The one who performs Bhakti is a Bhakta. However, we must not forget that the one who remains within the Devotion Sentience (Bhaktibhav Chaitanya) is the real Bhakta that is—the 'Shradhdhavan'.



Shradhdhavan is the Sanskrit name given in June 1972 by the Mother to an English woman who joined Auroville in 1970. After studying English Language and Literature at Bristol University in the U.K. She traveled extensively in Europe, Asia and Australia before coming to Auroville, where she lived ever since, playing the role as an educator, translator, editor and writer. Several of her poems, stories, essays and book reviews have been published in the Ashram Journal Mother India as well as in Heritage magazine. Since August 1999 she had been the Project Coordinator of Savitri Bhavan, a Centre of Sri Aurobindo and The Mother Studies which is a unit of SAILER (Sri Aurobindo International Institute of Educational Research). She edited the Savitri Bhavan's journal, Invocation: study notes on Savitri and led study courses on Savitri and The Life Divine.
